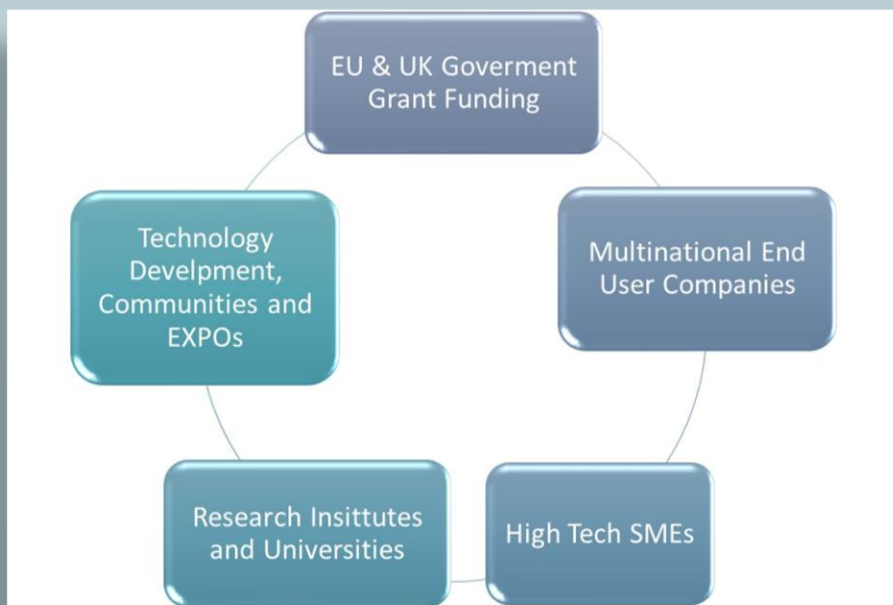


Innovation Management
